Dr Fleminger trained in psychiatry at the Maudsley Hospital, London, UK. From 1992 to 1996 he was Senior Lecturer in Psychiatry, running a community mental health team, at the Royal London Hospital. From 1996 to 2011 he was Consultant Neuropsychiatrist at the Maudsley Hospital where he set up and led the Lishman Brain Injury Unit. Since 1998 he has been Consultant Neuropsychiatrist at the Blackheath Brain Injury Rehabilitation Centre, providing a service for adults with acquired brain injury with cognitive, behavioural or psychiatric problems.

From 1999 to 2009 he was associate editor of the Journal of Neurology, Neurosurgery and Psychiatry, responsible for neuropsychiatry manuscripts. He was a member of the Expert Advisory Group for Psychiatry and Old Age Psychiatry of the Commission on Human Medicines, UK, responsible for making recommendations about drug prescribing. From 2005 to 2008 he was Chair of the Neuropsychiatry Special Interest Group of the UK Royal College of Psychiatrists. He has worked with the MoD to improve management of soldiers suffering head injuries. He has over 50 peer reviewed publications, largely in the field of neuropsychiatry and was Principle Investigator on a recently completed randomised control trial evaluation of cognitive behavioural therapy for patients with post concussion syndrome.
